Merchant finds that recycling is good for business

It didn't take long for Sam Abuhsan to persuade all 11 tenants of his commercial building at 191 87th St. to recycle instead of tossing everything into the garbage.

"It helps the atmosphere, it cleans up the Earth and it cuts down a lot on the garbage dumpster," he says.

"It's cheaper – recycling is free."

In fact, the two-story retail and office building has cut the number of dumpsters on site from three to one. Most of what used to go into the dumpster now goes into the half-dozen recycling carts behind the building.

Sam is now asking tenants and customers at his other businesses, Sam's Laundromat and All Star Coffee & Deli, to boost recycling, using his own experience as an example.

"I used to put junk mail in the garbage. Now I

pile it up in a box and put it in the recycling. "Empty cans for soda – I recycle. The dumpsters used to be overflowing. Not any more. "I'm 100 percent supportive of recycling. It's much better now," Abuhsan concluded.

DEBRIS BOX SERVICE

Allied Waste Services offers debris box containers for commercial and residential customers with more garbage than can be collected in regular pickup or annual cleanup. Contact Customer Care at (650) 756-1130 to place your order or to receive more information.

8 cu. yd. Debris Container — (8' W x 12' L x 30" H)

For disposing of heavy, dense materials such as dirt and concrete.

15 cu. yd. Debris Container — (8' W x 14' L x 4' H; 3-ton limit)

For disposing of residential, commercial and building material waste.

30 cu. yd. Debris Container — (8' W x 20' L x 6' H; 5-ton limit)

Also for disposing of residential, commercial and building material waste.

RECYCLE AND REUSE USED PAINT

San Mateo County recycles used paint dropped off at collection centers in several Peninsula cities and provides up to 25 gallons per resident of the recycled product for free.

All collected paint is transported to Redwood City, where it is separated by color and consolidated in 55-gallon drums. Contractors reprocess, purify and

remix the paint and dispense the final product in five-gallon cans. The next paint collection in Daly City is scheduled for March 10 at City Hall, 333 90th St. Additional information regarding drop-off locations and pickup of recycled paint is available on the county website at recycleworks.org or by calling (650) 363-4718.

RECYCLE HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES

Allied Waste of Daly City/Colma will accept household batteries dropped off at our offices at 1680 Edgeworth Ave. between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Another drop-off receptacle is located outside the cashier's office in Daly City City Hall, 333 90th St. No appointment is necessary.

Yard trimmings

Yard trimmings should be placed curbside by 4 a.m. on recycling day in containers no larger than 40 gallons or heavier than 40 pounds. Plastic bags are not recyclable and yard trimmings in plastic bags cannot be accepted.

ALWAYS RECYCLE

- Grass clippings
- Plant trimmings
- Leaves

- Tree limbs
- Ivy
- Pine cones, needles

**NOT ACCEPTED
FOR RECYCLING**

- Trash or rubbish
- Palm fronds
- Food scraps, fruits or vegetables

- Dirt or rocks

Q: "THE DRIVER LEFT SOME ITEMS BEHIND WHEN I PUT OUT MY ANNUAL CLEANUP. WHY DIDN'T HE TAKE EVERYTHING?"

— Daly City resident

Answer: There are several possible reasons. Here are some common ones and how to avoid having items left behind.

LOOSE ITEMS - If there are many items for pickup, they should be bundled, boxed or bagged.

ITEMS TOO HEAVY TO LIFT - Bundles, boxes and bags cannot weight more than 60 pounds. In addition, annual pickup can include two large items weighing up to 200 pounds each, such as a stove or refrigerator.

ELECTRONIC WASTE SUCH AS COMPUTERS, TELEVISIONS, FAX MACHINES, CELL PHONES AND MICROWAVES - These require special handling and cannot be collected as part of the annual cleanup.

TOO MANY ITEMS TO PICK UP - Annual cleanups can include no more than twelve 32-gallon garbage bags plus two large items.
